A blessing given by Joseph Keddington, Patriarch, upon the head of James Clifton Baxter, son of Reuben Emerson Baxter and Julia Strong. Born 2 May 1912, Garland, Utah.

Thou wert one of the noble spirits that was permitted to remain until the fulness of times when thou should have the privilege of coming into the world and be born of noble parents. Thy ancestros before thee were noble men and women and faith is implanted in thy heart and thou hast a testimony of the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and thou hast received the Priesthood, and thou hast joy in thy labors, and thou art one that is beloved by thine associates and through the blessings of the Lors they will draw near to thee and thou shalt have the gift of wisdom and shall lead, guide, and direct thine associates, and they shall love thee.
